- ▣ MYS Coaching Roster – 1 UEFA B License, 11 USSF A License/NSCAA Premier Diplomas, 10 USSF B License/NSCAA Advanced National Diploma, 7 USSF C License/NSCAA National Diploma License, 6 USSF D License, 2 USSF E, 2 Director of Coaching Diplomas and 14 National Youth License
- ▣ Jordan Felton– 2nd female in the U.S. (both MYS players) selected to train with Celtic FC; traveled to Scotland in March 2018
- ▣ U15 Girls ECNL team traveled to Italy in April playing 4 matches - Florence, Verona, Sassuolo, FC Roma; attended a FC Fiorentina match and had a private training session at Coverciano
- ▣ '07 Girls will travel to London for international games this summer
- ▣ '01 Boys Green – Won the USYS National League bracket and qualified for the USYS National Championships this summer!
- ▣ U14B Gold – 2nd place finish in NCSL D4; U19G White – 2nd place finish in NCSL D1
- ▣ U16, U17, U18 Girls ECNL - 1st in Conference – coaches Nadir Moumen and Brent Leiba - All teams, including the U15G, qualified for the National Championship Playoffs, June 21-27, Seattle, WA.

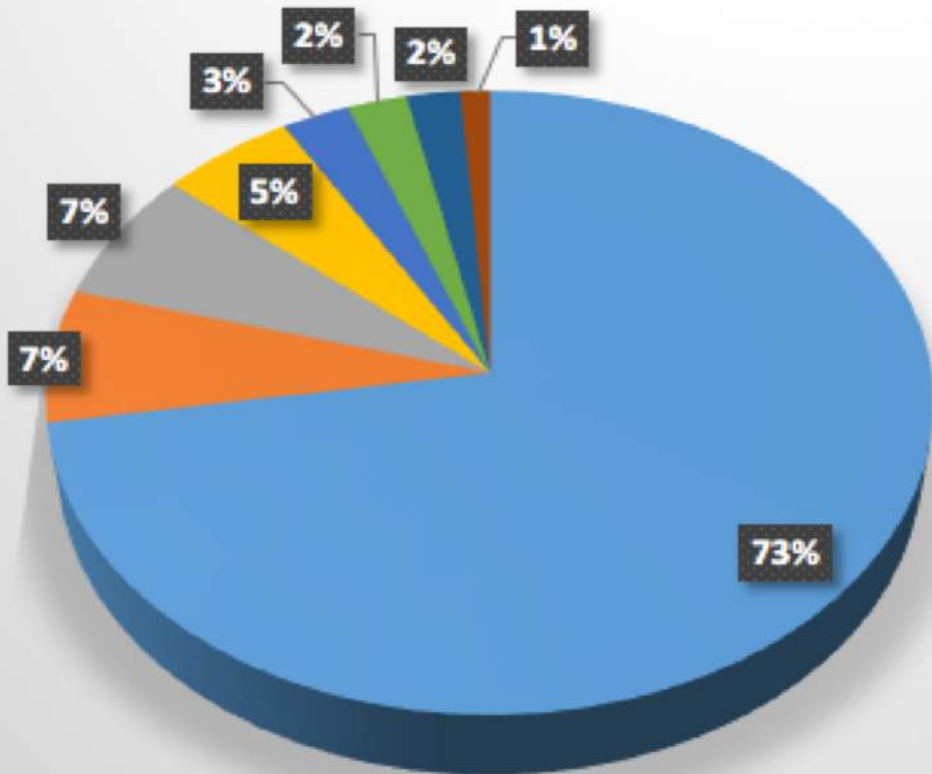


A Year of Success – Off the Fields...

- Renewal of Celtic F.C partnership
 - Renewal of South County Soccer partnership
 - International travel experience continues for MYS players – Italy and London
 - Assistance with travel team fees for players who qualified for financial aid
 - MYS creates partnership with MARS and LEIDOS
 - New turf replacement at SH2 and SH3 for 2018-19
 - After school program initiated at Timber Lane elementary school
 - Sponsored Fairfax County Cops and Kids soccer match
 - Initiated a referee mentoring program
 - Hosted and offered coaches/parents educational seminars and coaching certification opportunities
 - MYS Executive Director, Louise Waxler and MYS Director of Soccer, Keith Tabatznik were inducted into the Maryland Soccer Hall of Fame
 - Jaime Moreno was inducted into the DC Sports Hall of Fame
- Finances are strong:
- MYS is a 501c3 and is funded through membership dues and fees
 - Positive surplus from operations, no debt
 - Financial Audit in progress
 - Increasing commitment to financial aid
 - FY2018 – MYS awarded \$70,260 (70 players)

Looking Ahead: 2018-19

- ▣ New and Improved Programs include:
 - Coerver United and MYS enter into an agreement to train U8 Juniors
 - Acceptance into Boys ECNL
 - More teams at all levels led by Nationally Licensed coaches than previously.
 - International Trip Program – Partnership with WorldStrides to continue offering trips of a lifetime to our teams
 - Continued growth of our recreation program by adding Recreation Director position
 - Leidos to be MYS recreational jersey front sponsor
 - MYS signs 10 year agreement with FCPA for Spring Hill Fields 2 and 3
 - Possible addition of a U13 and older travel tournament – September 2018
 - Continued opportunities for Elite Programs with Celtic FC of Scotland
 - We continue to monitor the ever-changing landscape of youth soccer to ensure we are in the leagues and programs that best serve our membership by “providing a place for every player” – recreation to elite
